



Cornerstone Park Community Association, Inc. Pool Rules & Regulations 2011

Pool Hours: 9 am until Dusk
Adult Swim: 6 am until 9 am

1. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or parent-approved guardian who must be 16 years of age or older. No one under the age of 12 is allowed in the Pool Area without parent or guardian present.
2. No glass containers permitted inside the Pool Gate. Coolers may be checked.
3. **NO SMOKING WITHIN THE POOL GATE AREA. A SMOKING STATION IS PLACED OUTSIDE OF THE POOL GATE FOR PROPER DISPOSAL OF CIGARETTE BUTTS.**
4. Pets are not allowed inside of the Pool Gate.
5. Infants and children who are not "potty trained" must wear a swim diaper while swimming.
6. No running or horseplay on pool deck or in bathroom area.
7. No profanity or fighting.
8. No food, drink or gum allowed in the pool.
9. Food and drink allowed only on deck area only. No Gum Allowed.
10. Clean up after yourself! Put all trash in receptacles and clean up any spills on tables or chairs. This helps prevent bees.
11. Appropriate swimwear only. No cutoffs or street clothes.
12. Rafts are not permitted.
13. Kickboards may be used for lap swimming only.
14. Floatation devices and small ring buoys (under 24" in diameter) may be used in the shallow area. Floatation devices (i.e. noodles, etc.) will be allowed.
15. Children who wear water wings or life jackets in the pool must be closely supervised by a parent or guardian at all times when they are in the pool.
16. No diving allowed in water less than 8 ft.
17. Medications will not be dispensed at the pool.
18. Playing or loitering in the shower area is not permitted. Children should not be left unattended in the bathroom area. Parents are responsible for their children's actions.
19. No Frisbees or hard balls allowed.
20. Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed at the recreational facility by anyone under age 21.
21. Furniture is not allowed in the pool.
22. Refrain from using the pool if you have open wounds, sores or lesions.
23. No one is permitted in the pool parking areas after sunset. This area is to be used for member and guest parking during normal operating hours. Loitering in parking areas after hours will result in a call to the City of Raleigh Police.
24. Clubhouse renters may not access the pool from the pool deck. Pool users may not access clubhouse deck.
25. No loud music, musical instruments, amps, or microphones.

Remember:

Safety is the first priority for all Cornerstone Park Recreational Facility Members and guests. Pool rules and regulations are imposed to keep your pool experience enjoyable and safe. Members and guests will be expected to obey rules. Parents are expected to supervise their children at all times. The following discipline policy will be used to ensure the safety of members.

The Cornerstone Park Association reserves the right to revoke use of the facility for violation of Cornerstone Park policies. Pool users in violation of these rules will be reported to the Board of Directors & Elite Management and may have their pool key deactivated. Any suspicious activity or trespassing should be reported to 911.

Miscellaneous

Guest Policy

No more than three (3) guests per visit and limit your guest to three (3) times per year.

Parking

Parking is provided for members and guests only during operational hours. The parking lot is private property. Vehicles left in the parking area are subject to towing at the owner's expense. Unauthorized vehicles parked in the Handicapped Parking spaces will be fined and towed and reported to the City of Raleigh Police Department. No loitering is permitted.

Change of Policy

The Cornerstone Park Association reserves the right to amend or add to all policies contained herein at any time.

Mandatory Pool Closures

Per **Wake County Health Department regulations**, the pool may be closed due to the following circumstances:

- Fecal contamination (swim diapers must be used for small children)
- Broken glass in or around pool (Note: any Cornerstone Park member or guest who violates the “no glass” in the pool area rule will be responsible for the cost of draining and refilling the pool in the event that broken glass makes its way in the pool and warrants this action.)
- Chemical imbalance of pool water
- Pet and/or other animals found in the pool

In addition to the above-referenced points, it may be necessary to temporarily close the pool due to inclement weather. If there is bad weather at the start of the day and daily pool maintenance cannot be performed due to the weather, a delay may occur in the opening of the pool. If severe weather persists past 6:00 PM with no indication of clearing, the pool will remain closed for the rest of the day.

During inclement weather, the following safety procedures will be followed:

- Lightning – Lightning is life-threatening and water-seeking. If lightning is spotted, leave the pool area and seek shelter immediately. Members should get out of the water, wait 20 minutes or until the storm passes.
- Thunder – If thunder is heard, members should get out of the water, wait 20 minutes or until the storm passes. Members may remain on the deck away from the water. Each time thunder is heard; the 20-minute rule should begin again.
- Emergency – In the event of a severe storm, tornado, hurricane, or other catastrophe, members and guests must leave the facility. If it is unsafe to leave the area, members and guests should take shelter in the dressing room facility until it is safe to travel home.

Remember that safety is the first priority for all Cornerstone Park members and guests.
